History:

In 1969, the Urological Nurses Association (UNA) was formed. Interest grew throughout the United States, and local allied groups began to form. In 1972, the UNA and the Allied Health Professional Association merged to form the American Urological Association Allied (AUAA) and was incorporated as a non-profit organization. In 1994, AUAA celebrated its 25th Anniversary as a professional association. Also in 1995, the membership at the Annual Conference Business Meeting overwhelmingly approved a name change (in response to its long-range strategic planning committee's recommendation) to the Society of Urologic Nurses and Associates (SUNA). SUNA is proud to be the recognized authority of urologic nursing care and education and sets the standard of urologic education for healthcare providers and patients.
